Bredhurst Parish Council is allowed 7 Councillors. For months we have only had 6 in post but, with a recent resignation, we are now down to 5.

This comes at a critical time in our fight to save Lidsing and stop a major new spur road to the M2 being built in Bredhurst. Public support for the Against Lidsing campaign has been tremendous but we must have sufficient Councillors in place to continue the campaign and to deal with other village matters.

Without enough Councillors, meetings may be cancelled, and vital decisions cannot be made.

What is involved:

We need people of all ages, backgrounds and experiences who have an interest in their community.

You will be expected to attend monthly meetings, normally held on the 1st Wednesday of the month.

Full training will be given.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Over 18 years of age
- A British citizen, or an eligible Commonwealth citizen
- Not be a bankrupt or have received a jail sentence within the past 5 years (suspended or not)
- Live in or within 3 miles of the Bredhurst parish boundary for the whole of the 12 months prior to your nomination and the day of election or
- Work in the Parish for the whole of the 12 months prior to your nomination and the day of election or
- Own land or other premises within the Parish boundary
